

# 2010 UWMP Guidebook

## ❖ Consists of 2 parts

- ◆ Part I: Preparing a UWMP. It provides specific requirements of what is to be included in an UWMP, organized by general topic. It is based on legislative requirements, although some 'optional' issues are also included (climate change, etc)
- ◆ Part II: UWMP Supporting Information. Details on specific topics identified in Part I.

# Draft Guidebook Modifications

There are several areas where there will be some changes between the Draft and Final versions of the guidebook

- ❖ AB 1420 and DMM UWMP documentation

- ❖ Water Use Reduction Plan

- ❖ Water Conservation Act of 2009 tables




# Section 2: System Description

## ❖ Key changes since 2005:

- ◆ Population estimates are to comply with the Water Conservation Bill of 2009 requirements
- ◆ Service area maps are requested for baseline calculation documentation


## ❖ Questions DWR has received:


- ❖ Consider indirect potable reuse opportunities for possible recycled water uses


- ◆ Water Supply Reliability



# Key Anticipated Dates

- ❖ Guidebook comment period is being extended – when we release the proposed changes to the final, we will indicate the end of the comment period
- ❖ Early February: Final Guidebook release
- ❖ Early February: DOST will go live
- ❖ Mid February: Start statewide workshops
- ❖ July 1: UWMP adoption deadline
- ❖ Aug 1: UWMPs due to DWR
