

Agricultural Farm-Gate Delivery Report (AB 1404 of 2007)

Due annually beginning no later than July 30, 2013

Required from suppliers either publicly or privately owned, supplying 2,000 acre-feet or more of surface water annually for agricultural purposes or serving 2,000 or more acres of agricultural land.

Disclaimer: Agricultural water supplier's total water use will always be different from Farm-Gate deliveries since measurement at these points do not account for other water management practices such as groundwater recharge/conjunctive use, conveyance losses, water transfers, water delivered for environmental purposes, reuse, wheeling to other agencies, urban use, recreational uses, rainfall, and spills entering or leaving the agency's service area, etc. Farm-gate delivery information should not be used to quantify agricultural water use efficiency pursuant to Section 10608.64. Water Agency may provide additional information and clarifications below:

1. "Aggregated farm-gate delivery data" means information reflecting the total volume of water an agricultural water supplier provides to its customers and is calculated by totaling its deliveries to individual customers. (AB 1404, Sec. 531(a))
 2. "Best professional practices" means practices attaining and maintaining accuracy of measurement and reporting devices and methods. (AB 1404, Sec. 531(d)). Section 10608.48(b)(1) requires measurement with sufficient accuracy pursuant to DWR ag water measurement regulation.
