Senate Bill X 7-7

- SB X 7- 7 enacted as part of “water package”
- Requires ag suppliers to prepare and submit a plan to DWR, measure deliveries and charge by volume
- Places 20% goal in statute, establishes the process to achieve savings
- Conditions future state water loans and grants to compliance
- Directs state agencies to work together and standardize water suppliers data reporting

SB X 7-7

■ Directs DWR

- To consult with CUWCC, AWMC, CPUC, CDPH, CBDA, SWRCB on various parts
- To develop regulation for CII process water
- To develop regulation for agricultural water measurement
- To update EWPMs
- To convene a CII Task Force and develop alternative BMPs for CII

SBX 7-7

■ Directs

- DWR to develop technical methodologies and criteria for adjustment
- Urban water suppliers to set per capita targets
- DWR to develop a water use target method considering certain flexibilities
- Urban water suppliers to report progress to DWR in 2015 UWM Plans
- DWR to report to the legislature and make recommendation on needed changes if the state is not “on track” to meet per capita targets

DWR Plan of implementation

- Convene CII Task Force, 2010
- Begin developing technical methodologies by October 2010
- Develop a target method by December 2010
- Update UWMP Guidebook, 2010
- Adopt process water regulation, 2010

DWR Plan

- Develop agriculture efficiency quantification method
- Develop standardized data reporting forms
- Adopt agricultural water measurement regulation
- Report to the Legislature by 2010, 2012, 2016
- Develop AWM Plan Guidebook, 2010
- Grant criteria by 2013 and 2016

DWR-public process

- Form an Urban Stakeholder Committee
- Form an Agriculture Stakeholder Committee
- Hold public workshops
- Post information on DWR website
