Central Valley Flood Protection Plan Round 2 Management Actions Workshops

The California Department of Water Resources' (DWR) Central Valley Flood Planning Office is set to begin the second round of Management Actions (MA) Workshops for the Central Valley Flood Protection Plan (CVFPP) beginning August 24. The Round 2 Management Actions Workshops are a key component of planning and engagement activities for the 2012 CVFPP, and will focus on applying MAs to urban, rural/agricultural, and small communities, and the integration of water supply, environmental, and other benefits with the different MAs. This information will provide the foundation towards December's completion of the second of four planning phases for the 2012 CVFPP.

The purpose of each workshop is to focus on how MAs can be applied in different community settings, and how they can be integrated with other benefits. Round 2 workshops include three community application workshops and one integration workshop. Eleven category-based workshops were held in July.
