- Include structural and nonstructural strategies and actions
- May address a single goal or multiple goals
- Building blocks for regional solutions
- Broad and not yet site specific

# Floodplain Management Management Actions

- MA-025\_Acquire floodplain property that can contribute to flood management system efficiency.
- MA-026\_Manage municipal stormwater to provide regional or systemwide flood benefits.
- MA-028\_Coordinate and streamline floodplain mapping to improve consistency of floodplain delineation and assessment of flood risk.
- MA-074\_Increase flood risk awareness through outreach.

# Floodplain Management Management Actions

- MA-075\_ Provide technical assistance to local agencies for compliance and grant application assistance.
- MA-076\_ Assist in development of local flood management plan updates.
- MA-077\_ Improve awareness of Community Rating System insurance-rate adjusting program.
- MA-078\_ Develop mandatory flood insurance programs that are consistent with the risk of flooding.

# Floodplain Management Management Actions

- MA-079\_Increase public understanding of FEMA maps and policies.
- MA-080\_Eliminate subsidies for structures that are repetitively damaged.


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# Management Actions Timeline
