Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee will meet

The Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee will meet November 17 in Sacramento. Meeting notice is [here](#). Additionally, the Delta Science Program will present the [Interim Science Action Agenda](#) (ISAA). The ISAA is a key component of implementing the Delta Science Plan, and summarizes and synthesizes a range of science actions identified by multiple agencies and organizations.

Also, the Delta Science Program, the UC Davis Center for Aquatic Biology & Aquaculture, and the UC Davis Center for Watershed Sciences will conduct a free symposium, which is open to the public, December 9 at the University of California, Davis, titled "[Meeting Nature Halfway on a Floodway - The Yolo Bypass as a Reconciled Ecosystem](#)." The symposium brings together several key investigators — engineers, ecologists, and economists — for a day-long public discussion on how farming and floods might be reconciled with fish and fowl.
