



## Conservancy is hosting the Delta waterway cleanup

The Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy (Conservancy) is hosting the Delta Waterway Cleanup April 18 as a part of [Creek Week 2015](#). The cleanup will be at two Delta locations — Lower Morrison Creek at the Bufferlands and Sherman Island. The Lower Morrison Creek site features a water quality monitoring demonstration. The Sherman Island site offers free tire recycling for illegally dumped tires, sponsored by the Conservancy in partnership with the Bridgestone Tires 4ward Tire Recycling Program.
