- Staff work to respond to the Committee request for a list of near-term, high-impact science actions and seek Committee endorsement for implementation.
- The California Water Commission's role and current activities for improving statewide water storage.
- State and federal coordination activities to combat invasive aquatic weeds and the impact on the Delta.
- Progress to integrate multiagency activities, including ongoing work in the Yolo Bypass.
