The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Sacramento District (USACE) is evaluating a permit application for a proposed Delta Wetlands project. USACE has prepared a Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS) and requests public comment on the SDEIS and the pending permit application.
