



## BDCP RDEIR/SDEIS is available for public review/comment

DWR and the Bureau of Reclamation have released the [Bay Delta Conservation Plan \(BDCP\)/California WaterFix Partially Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report/Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement \(RDEIR/SDEIS\)](#), which includes three new alternatives, for public review and comment. There will be [two public open house meetings, July 28 in Sacramento and July 29 in Walnut Grove](#). The public comment period began July 10 and ends August 31. ## Flood conservation strategy is available for public comment

DWR has prepared a Draft Central Valley Flood System Conservation Strategy for a 60-day public review and comment period. This is an integral component of the 2017 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan. A review guidance document is also available.
