



## DWR, Reclamation submit change petition to SWRCB

DWR and the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) have submitted a [change petition](#) to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB). This is a petition for a change to the water rights necessary to allow for the implementation of key components of the [California WaterFix](#). The petition requests SWRCB approval to add points of diversion and rediversion to the existing water right permits (and existing diversion authorization) held by the State Water Project and Central Valley Project. The SWRCB's change petition process, associated hearing for the California WaterFix, and SWRCB eventual decision on the petition, are solely about and limited to the California WaterFix proposal to add additional diversion points on the Sacramento River.
