The Delta Independent Science Board (Delta ISB) will hold a teleconference, September 16, to discuss the Board's comments on the Recirculated Draft EIR/Supplemental Draft EIS for the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP)/California WaterFix. There will also be updates on other reviews including the *Flows and Fishes* report; the draft *Adaptive Management* report; and reviews on water quality, Delta levees, and the Delta as an Evolving Place.
