USACE, CVFPB, & DWR will host flood risk public meetings

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Sacramento District (USACE), Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB), and DWR will host public scoping meetings, November 3 in West Sacramento and November 9 in Marysville, to identify flood-risk reduction and ecosystem restoration opportunities along the Sacramento River. The meetings will provide a brief overview of the study purpose, National Environmental Policy Act/California Environmental Quality Act processes, and how the public can help shape a potential project for federal participation.
