



SWRCB will conduct pre-hearing on California WaterFix

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) will conduct a pre-hearing in Sacramento January 28 and will continue it, if necessary, to January 29. The pre-hearing is about the [DWR and U.S. Bureau of Reclamation joint petition](#) to add three new points of diversion and/or points of redirection of water to specified water right permits for the State Water Project and the Central Valley Project associated with the California WaterFix project.
