The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) is responsible for developing and modifying the Bay-Delta Water Quality Control Plan, which establishes water quality control measures needed to provide reasonable protection of beneficial uses of water in the Bay-Delta watershed. The SWRCB also implements the Bay-Delta Plan through water rights and other measures and otherwise administers water rights in the Bay-Delta watershed.
