



## DWR and Reclamation submit testimony to SWRCB

DWR and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) submitted testimony to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) as required for the upcoming public hearings on a request to add three new points of diversion to the State Water Project, with coordinated operations for the Central Valley Project, for California WaterFix. ## Tule Red Tidal Restoration Plan is certified to be consistent with Delta Plan

The [State and Federal Contractors Water Agency](#) has [certified](#) that its [Tule Red Tidal Restoration Project](#) in the Suisun Marsh, as a Covered Action, is consistent with the Delta Stewardship Council's [Delta Plan](#). No appeal was filed with regard to that certification. The proposed project would restore approximately 420 acres of existing managed brackish wetlands, owned by Westervelt Ecological Services and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, to tidal habitat and would benefit federally and State-listed delta smelt, longfin smelt, and salmonids.

## Seminar topic is farms as floodplain

The Delta Science Program, Ecosystem Restoration Program, and Surface Water Ambient Monitoring Program will present a seminar June 20 in Sacramento, titled Farms as Floodplain: Five Years of Experimental Flooding of Yolo Bypass Ag Land. Lynn Takata of DWR will discuss the Agricultural Floodplain Study, a report which examines how juvenile Chinook salmon benefit from flooding the Yolo Bypass, which is one of the Delta Plan's six high-priority habitat restoration areas.
