## Sacramento County Superior Court issues tentative ruling on Delta Plan

The Sacramento County Superior Court has issued a tentative ruling on the requests for clarification of the recent ruling on the Delta Stewardship Council's Delta Plan. The ruling states, "The Delta Plan is invalid and must be set aside pending revisions. In light of this finding, there is nothing currently before the Court to review under CEQA. As provided in the introduction to this ruling, in ascertaining the Court's final ruling, the Ruling on Submitted Matter should be read in conjunction with this ruling on the Motions for Clarification. No further ruling will be issued on the merits."

## DBW will begin herbicide treatment for Brazilian waterweed at Bethel Island

The California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) will begin herbicide treatment of Brazilian waterweed (*Egeria densa*) July 11 in the Bethel Island region, continuing to November 4. DBW will also concurrently treat curly-leaf pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*). More information is in this [news release](#).

## CDFA is accepting applications for SWEEP grants

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) is accepting applications for the State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program (SWEEP) grants. An estimated \$18 million of financial assistance will be available for irrigation systems that reduce greenhouse gases and save water at California agricultural operations. Prospective applicants must access the Application Guidelines at [www.cdfa.ca.gov/go/SWEEP](http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/go/SWEEP) for detailed information on eligibility and program requirements. To streamline and expedite the application process, CDFA has partnered with the State Water Resources Control Board, which hosts an online application tool, Financial Assistance Application Submittal Tool (FAAST). All prospective applicants must register for a FAAST account at <https://faast.waterboards.ca.gov>. Applications and all supporting information must be submitted using FAAST by August 5.
