## DWR and Reclamation release revised biological assessment for California WaterFix

DWR and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) have released a [revised biological assessment for the California WaterFix](#) to the National Marine Fisheries Service and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service with a request to begin the formal consultation process under Section 7 of the U.S. Endangered Species Act. The goal of California WaterFix is to balance the needs of California residents with the needs of Delta fish and wildlife. This biological assessment articulates how California WaterFix would be operated to meet the needs of endangered species.
