## **Delta ISB will hold a two-day meeting, October 13 — 14**

The Delta Independent Science Board (Delta ISB) will hold a two-day meeting October 13 — 14 in Elk Grove. On October 13, the Delta ISB will discuss succession planning and hear a presentation from the State Water Resources Control Board on Phase 2 of the Bay-Delta Plan update. The meeting will include a field trip to the Cosumnes River Preserve. On October 14, the Delta ISB will review the status of its thematic review efforts before touring the operational and laboratory facilities at the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District.
