



Science board to hold workshop on Delta stressors

The Delta Independent Science Board (ISB) is holding a public workshop on Wednesday, Jan. 12, and Thursday, Jan. 13, to evaluate the relative importance of multiple stressors to the Delta. The ISB will provide a report on its findings to assist in preparing the Delta Plan.

Water transfer program reports available for public review

Two Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact reports are available for public review after being released by the Bureau of Reclamation. One assesses a water transfer program between Central Valley Project contractors [south of the Delta](#). The other is for a program between [Central Valley Project Friant Division and Cross Valley](#) contractors.

Bureau of Reclamation sets meetings for proposed water deals

The Bureau of Reclamation and the San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority have scheduled three public meetings on the effects of proposed long-term north-to-south water transfers. The meetings will look at topics to address in a joint environmental impact statement/environmental impact report.
