



CALFED plans 2-day workshop on ammonia effects in the Delta

The CALFED Science Program will host a two-day public workshop on Tuesday and Wednesday, March 10 and 11, to identify data and science gaps and to develop a scientific research framework to assess the role of ammonium and ammonia in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and Suisun Bay ecosystem. The workshop will consist of brief presentations by a panel of subject experts, detailed discussion between the panel and stakeholders, and numerous opportunities for public comments and questions.
