



Second staff draft of Delta Plan available for review

The [second staff draft](#) of the Delta Plan has been released and is available on the Delta Stewardship Council (DSC) website. This version puts draft regulations and recommendations on the table for the council, stakeholders and the public to discuss and make recommendations for successive drafts. The second draft includes new chapters on science and adaptive management, water quality, governance and financing. More details are available in a DSC [news release](#).

DSC to look at Delta Plan elements during two-day meeting

The Delta Stewardship Council will be meeting two days this week, today and tomorrow, March 24 and 25, in West Sacramento. IEP to host Delta workshop in Folsom

The Interagency Ecological Program (IEP) will host its annual workshop on the Delta ecological system on Wednesday, March 30, in Folsom. Sessions include implications for future survival of Delta smelt from four climate change scenarios, and improving future ecosystem resilience in the Delta.
