Antioch Recycled Water Project gets funds from USBR

The Bureau of Reclamation has awarded a \$780,859 contract under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act to the Delta Diablo Sanitation District, for the Antioch Recycled Water Project in Contra Costa County.
