## Proposal to improve Delta leads to statewide urban water conservation plan

The Governor's 20X2020 Agency Team on Water Conservation will conduct a workshop tomorrow, Friday, May 29, to hear what the public thinks about its plan to conserve water in urban areas. In 2008, Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger introduced a plan for improving the Delta. The governor directed state agencies to develop a plan to reduce statewide per capita urban water use by 20 percent by the year 2020.
