DWR climate change
white paper includes
strategy for Delta

DWR has released a white paper on climate change, and there is a strategy for the Delta. Strategy 7 calls for fixing the Delta water supply, quality and ecosystem conditions. [The report can be found here.](#) In part the strategy calls on state agencies and stakeholders to continue supporting the work of the Delta Vision Task Force, Bay-Delta Conservation Plan, Delta Risk Management Strategy, and the Delta Regional Ecosystem Restoration Implementation Plan and to "encourage the incorporation of adaptive responses to climate change for the Delta in all four processes."
