Next week's meeting of the Delta Stewardship Council (DSC) will include a public hearing to take comments on the [draft environmental impact report](#) (EIR) for the Delta Plan. The meeting will be Thursday, Dec. 15, in Sacramento. A presentation on the Delta Protection Commission's [economic sustainability](#) plan is also on the [agenda](#).
