



## CVFPB to discuss draft resolution for adoption of flood plan

The [draft resolution](#) to adopt the [2012 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan](#) will be discussed at a meeting of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB) tomorrow, May 25, in Sacramento. Public comments on the draft resolution will be accepted through Thursday, May 31.

## Comments on errors in draft valley flood plan due tomorrow

The CVFPB has also decided to accept public comments on errors and omissions in the draft [2012 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan](#). The draft errata and instructions for submitting comments are available on the [CVFPB website](#). Comments are due tomorrow, May 25. The errata are not considered substantive changes to the development of the flood protection plan.

## Science conference asking for presentation abstracts by June 8

A little more than two weeks remain before the deadline to [submit abstracts](#) for presentations at the [Bay-Delta Science Conference](#). The abstracts must be in by Friday, June 8, and must cover a topic relevant to one of the [conference themes](#). The conference will be Oct. 16-18 in Sacramento. Its goal is to provide new information to scientists, engineers, resource managers, and stakeholders working on Bay-Delta issues.



## Delta Science Fellows Program deadline less than two weeks away

Applications for the [2012 Delta Science Fellows Program](#) are due less than two weeks from today. The deadline is Monday, June 4. As many as 11 fellowships for pre-doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers will be awarded. The proposals must address one of five policy areas outlined in the Delta Plan.
