The Delta Stewardship Council (DSC) has posted the [agenda](#) for next week's meeting in West Sacramento. It will be held Thursday, Nov. 15. The council will receive updates on the Delta Plan and the review of the [Bay-Delta Conservation Plan](#) environmental impact report. The Delta Conservancy is holding an [overview of levee projects](#) and habitat restoration in the Delta and Suisun Marsh on Wednesday, Nov. 14 in Courtland.

Third Bay-Delta Plan workshop to be held next week

A [third workshop](#) to discuss the basis for considering changes to the 2006 [Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco/Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Estuary](#) (Bay-Delta Plan) will be held Nov. 13 and 14, in Sacramento. This workshop will look at analytical tools for evaluating water supply. Previous workshops examined ecosystem changes and fishery resources. They are part of the State Water Resources Control Board's review of the Bay-Delta Plan.



Final version of ag water management guidebook put online

The final version of [A Guidebook to Assist Agricultural Water Suppliers to Prepare a 2012 Agricultural Water Management Plan](#) has been posted on the DWR website. The guidebook offers explanations and suggestions to help agricultural water suppliers comply with requirements of the California Water Code and the California Code of Regulations. Use of the book is not mandatory.

California's IRWM initiative highlighted in case studies report

A report on managing water resources includes a chapter on the success of California's integrated regional water management (IRWM) initiative. [Case Studies in Integrated Water Resources Management: From Local Stewardship to National Vision](#) has been published by the American Water Resources Association (AWRA). It credits IRWM with encouraging innovation at the local level, while requiring regions to work through a water management framework.
