Clifton Court Forebay Project is ready for public review

DWR has released the Draft Initial Study/Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, (IS/MND) for the Clifton Court Forebay Fishing Facility Project for public review. The proposed project consists of installing an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant fishing pier, a boat dock, a restroom, two parking spaces, a trail, and trail access. Also included in the project will be a staging area, a concrete pad and retaining wall, security fencing and gates, bicycle rack, equipment shed, and lighting and signage.
