Save the date - September 21 Coastal Cleanup Day

The Delta Protection Commission and the California Coastal Commission will host the 29th Annual California Coastal Cleanup Day on September 21. In 2012, more than 65,000 volunteers removed almost 770,000 pounds of trash and recyclables from California's beaches, lakes, and waterways, covering more than 2,400 miles of coastline and inland shorelines throughout the state. In the Delta counties, nearly 10,000 volunteers collected more than 128,000 pounds of trash and recyclables. There are many cleanup sites needing volunteers in the Delta areas.
