



Public review of BDCP, EIR/EIS drafts begins November 15

[The BDCP \(Bay Delta Conservation Plan\) Public Review Draft](#) and [Consultant Administrative Draft EIR/EIS](#) is scheduled for release November 15 for public review and comment. (The federal shutdown may affect this schedule.)



If the plan is released November 15, the formal public review period will extend until March 17. Written comments on the Public Review Draft BDCP and EIR/EIS would be accepted during this period and would be considered in the development of the Final EIR/EIS. Details on how to provide comments will be available in November.
