

# Transportation/Navigation and Utilities and Public Services

WOULD THE PROJECT...

## TRANSPORTATION/NAVIGATION

- Cause an increase in traffic exceeding street system capacity (i.e., result in a substantial increase in either the number of vehicle trips, the volume to capacity ratio on roads, or congestion at intersections)?
- Exceed level of service standard for designated roads or highways?
- Substantially increase hazards because of a design feature (e.g., sharp curves or dangerous intersections) or incompatible uses (e.g., farm equipment)?
- Result in inadequate emergency access?

## UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES

- Exceed wastewater treatment requirements of the applicable Regional Water Quality Control Board?
- Require or result in the construction of new water or wastewater treatment facilities or expansion of existing facilities, causing other environmental effects?
- Require or result in the construction of new storm water drainage facilities or expansion of existing facilities, causing other environmental effects?
- Require new or expanded entitlements needed for water supply?
- Result in an inadequate capacity to serve the project's demand beyond existing commitments?
- Be served by a landfill with insufficient permitted capacity to accommodate the project's solid waste disposal needs?
- Fail to comply with federal, state, and local statutes and regulations related to solid waste management and disposal?
- Require new or expanded electrical or natural gas facilities, causing other environmental effects?
- Result in a need for new or altered governmental facilities and services including police, fire, medical and schools, causing other environmental impacts?
