Sealed bids for SOUTH BAY PUMPING PLANT – INITIAL, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT ENLARGEMENT, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, DELTA FIELD DIVISION, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 06-04, CONTRACT NO. C51315, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California 95814, not later than **2:00 P.M. on WEDNESDAY, MAY 31, 2006**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Reinforced concrete pump station, 2. 78 Inch Diameter Steel Pipe and Fittings: a. Blowoffs, manholes, hydrostatic testing, b. Reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) access structure. 3. Insulating sleeve type couplings, 4. Welded steel discharge manifold, lines and appurtenances, including anchorage and encasement, 5. Hatch cover, steel trashrack panels and steel stop log gates, 6. Service Bay Building: a. Structural steel frame, b. Steel roof and wall panels, c. Gantry rails, d. Overhead coiling door, 7. Roads, drainage facilities, security gate, cattle guard, fencing and steel guard posts, 8. Cast-in-drill-hole (CIDH) piles, 9. Reinforced concrete, 10. Concrete reinforcing steel, 11. Clearing and grubbing, 12. Stone slope protection, 13. Earthwork: a. Excavation, b. Compacted backfill, c. Consolidated backfill, d. Compacted embankment, e. Rice straw wattles and silt fence as required for erosion control, 14. Electrical Work: a. Wiring, b. Grounding, c. Embedded conduit and appurtenances, d. Testing, 15. Mechanical Work: a. Embedded piping, b. 8 inch energy dissipater, c. Piping supports, hangers and appurtenances, d. Fire hydrant, e. Valves, 16. Architectural Work: a. Metal doors and frames, b. Door hardware, c. Overhead coiling doors, d. Painting and coating, e. Roof drains, f. Guardrail, g. Temporary wooden hatch cover, h. Thermal insulation, i. Sheet metal, j. Gypsum wallboards, k. Sealants, and 17. Seeding.
