Sealed bids for, DISCHARGE LINE AND BRUSHY CREEK PIPELINE NO. 3, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT ENLARGEMENT, STATE WATER FACILITIES, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 06-09, CONTRACT NO. C51320, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California 95814, not later than **2:00 P.M. on WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2006**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Providing approximately 3.7 miles of 78 inch buried pipe (concrete and/or steel) from the South Bay Aqueduct Pumping Plant to Dyer Reservoir,
2. Furnishing approximately 400 feet of 78 inch diameter steel pipe, to be delivered to the Department to be installed by others under the Dyer Reservoir Contract,
3. Excavation and backfill,
4. Concrete encasement,
5. PVC conduits from the South Bay Aqueduct Pumping Plant to Surge Tank No. 3 site,
6. Cathodic protection system,
7. Concrete access structures,
8. Install Department furnished valves,
9. Coatings and linings, and
10. Seeding.
