Sealed bids for FURNISH CHECK STRUCTURE EQUIPMENT, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT ENLARGEMENT, STATE WATER FACILITIES, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 08-21, CONTRACT NO. C51385, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California 95814, not later than **2:00 P.M. on WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2008**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Design and fabricate the following equipment for Dyer Check 1, Patterson Check 3, Lupin Check 4, Arroyo Seco Check 5, Arroyo Mocho Check 6, and Del Valle Check 7: a. Ten radial gates with cathodic protection, b. Ten electric actuators for radial gate hoist assemblies, c. Ten radial gate hoist assemblies and associated control systems, d. Electric actuator special tools and spare parts, e. Radial gate hoist assembly special tools and spare parts, f. Five stop logs, and g. Three stop log storage racks,
2. Design and fabricate one trash removal system for Dyer-Altamont Check 2 and two trash removal systems for Del Valle Check 7.
3. Delivery of equipment: a. Equipment specified in above Subparagraphs 1.b, 1.d, and 1.e shall be delivered to Delta Field Division O&M Center approximately 12 miles northwest of Tracy, California, b. Remaining heavy equipment specified in above Paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be delivered to Patterson Yard approximately 5 miles east of Livermore, California. However, detachable accessories of the heavy equipment, as specified in Paragraph 1.08 C, shall be delivered to Delta Field Division O&M Center, c. Directions to delivery locations are specified in Paragraph 1.08 A, d. Loading, delivery, and unloading of equipment from Patterson Yard to various work sites will be done by others, and 1) The detachable accessories of the equipment will be assembled/installed by others.
4. Provide the following services: a. Training programs for electric actuators and trash removal systems, b. Services of an erecting engineer and overtime services of an erecting engineer for radial gates, electric actuators, and trash removal systems, and c. Liaison services.
