Sealed bids for 69 KV TRANSMISSION LINE AND BANKS SWITCHYARD, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT ENLARGEMENT, STATE WATER FACILITIES, SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 09-06, CONTRACT NO. C51391, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California 95814, not later than **2:00 P.M. on WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2009**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Excavation of new switchyard, distribution lines poles, and transmission line poles,
2. Trucking and compacted embankment of excavated materials,
3. Aggregate base and asphalt concrete for the new switchyard,
4. Construction of reinforced concrete foundations,
5. Fabrication and construction of structural steel switchyard supports and towers,
6. Access roads to transmission and distribution lines,
7. Seeding excavated slopes of switchyard,
8. Install Department furnished transformers, high voltage equipment, and protective relays,
9. Furnish and install Banks Switchyard modifications prefabricated control buildings and equipment,
10. Furnish and install 69 kV transmission line poles and equipment,
11. Furnish, install, and refurbish 13.8 kV distribution line poles and equipment,
12. Furnish and install new O&M substation, low voltage switchgear, and electronic equipment. Remove and dispose of existing equipment,
13. Remove and dispose existing 13.8 kV and 5 kV distribution power lines and poles, and
14. Furnish and install new Skinner Fish Facility low voltage switchgear. Remove and dispose of existing equipment.

The Department encourages bidders to explore certification as a Small Business and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise and to utilize certified Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises during the contract term. To encourage bidders to meet the DVBE participation goal, the Department will apply a three percent DVBE incentive to bids that meet or exceed the DVBE participation goal for this contract.

Contractor's license classification required for this work: A or C-10 .

All bidders shall be prequalified by the Department. Bid documents will be furnished only to prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the State Contract Act and Document 00040 – Prequalification.
