Sealed bids for SEAL AND PAVE ROADS AND PARKING AREAS – 2010, SAN LUIS AND SAN JOAQUIN FIELD DIVISIONS, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, MERCED, KERN, KINGS, AND FRESNO COUNTIES, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 10-02, CONTRACT NO. C51408, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, at the Lancaster Project Headquarters, 121 West Carriage Lane, Suite 101, Lancaster, California 93534, not later than **11:00 A.M., THURSDAY, JUNE 10, 2010** at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office. Lancaster Project Headquarters is located on a new street just north of the NW corner of Division Street and East Avenue K.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Seal and Pave Roads and Parking Areas – Merced, Kern, Kings, and Fresno Counties, California. Work shall consist of, but not limited to, furnishing all labor, material, equipment, tools, and services required for repair of potholes, trenches, and unstable sections, clean out depression and filling with new material, cut out deep depressions and replace with new material, application of seal coat, placing, and compacting of asphalt concrete pavement for roadways and parking lots, to the lines, grades, and dimensions shown on the drawings and as specified herein. a. Asphaltic emulsion for chip seal over existing sealed or paved areas, b. Screenings, c. Asphaltic emulsion for fog seal coat, d. Asphaltic emulsion for chip seal over recycled areas, e. Traffic stripes and pavement markings, f. Slurry seal coat Type 2. g. Slurry seal coat Type 3, h. Miscellaneous pavement repairs, and i. Pavement section recycling.

Questions relating to bidding may be directed to the Contract Coordinator of DWR in Sacramento, at the contacts listed above. Questions or requests for clarification of the drawings or specifications shall be made in writing at least 10 days before the scheduled opening of bids. Response, if appropriate, will be furnished/sent to all prospective bidders on DWR Planholder's List. A tour or meeting regarding the work site will be scheduled and conducted by the Department. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT INTERESTED CONTRACTORS ATTEND THE INSPECTION TRIP.**

The Department encourages bidders to explore certification as a Small Business and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise and to utilize certified Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises during the contract term.

Contractor's license classification required for this work: A or C-12 .

All bidders shall be prequalified by the Department. Bid documents will be furnished only to prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the State Contract Act and Document 00040 – Prequalification.
