Sealed bids for EMERGENT WETLANDS CREATION, OROVILLE WILDLIFE AREA, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, OROVILLE FIELD DIVISION, BUTTE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 10-07, CONTRACT NO. C51411, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California 95814, not later than **2:00 P.M. on WEDNESDAY, JUNE 23, 2010**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Clear and grub the work site to prepare for earthwork operations, 2. Fence the Work Site Boundaries and Exclusion Zones, 3. Excavate two ponds and remove the earth materials from the work site as the Contractor's property, 4. Excavate bedding material from the borrow area of the south pond and transport and place the material in the areas of the north pond, 5. Grade the pond areas after excavating the earth material from the ponds and after placing the bedding material, and 6. Pay to the Department a fixed unit price per cubic yard for the excavation material hauled away as the Contractor's property. The fixed unit price entered by the Department onto the bid schedule is designated as a Material Offset value which will offset the payment to the Contractor to construct the work.

Forms of bid and contract, drawings and specifications for the project may be obtained only at the Department of Water Resources (DWR), 1416 Ninth Street, Room 418, Sacramento, California, between the hours of 7:30 a.m.-12:00 noon and 12:30-4:00 p.m. or by mail upon written request to the Department of Water Resources, P. O. Box 942836, Sacramento, California 94236-0001, Attention: Jim Veres, Spec. No. 10-07, Telephone (916) 653-4867, Fax (916) 653-6166, or by e-mail at doe_specs@water.ca.gov. Drawings and specifications may be seen at the above location or at the office of the Department at Lancaster Project Headquarters, 121 West Carriage Lane, Suite 101, Lancaster, California, 93534. Questions relating to bidding may be directed to the Contract Coordinator of DWR in Sacramento, at the contacts listed above. Questions or requests for clarification of the drawings or specifications shall be made in writing at least 10 days before the scheduled opening of bids. Response, if appropriate, will be furnished/sent to all prospective bidders on DWR Planholder's List. A tour or meeting regarding the work site will be scheduled and conducted by the Department. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT INTERESTED CONTRACTORS ATTEND THE INSPECTION TRIP.**

The Department encourages bidders to explore certification as a Small Business and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise and to utilize certified Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises during the contract term.

Contractor's license classification required for this work: A .

All bidders shall be prequalified by the Department. Bid documents will be furnished only to prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the State Contract Act and Document 00040 – Prequalification.
