Sealed bids for REPLACE SEPTIC TANKS, SEWAGE PIPING AND PUMPS, A. D. EDMONSTON, CHRISMAN, TEERINK, AND BUENA VISTA PUMPING PLANTS, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, SAN JOAQUIN FIELD DIVISION, KERN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 11-04, CONTRACT NO. C51433, will be received by the Department of Water Resources, at the Lancaster Project Headquarters, 121 West Carriage Lane, Suite 101, Lancaster, California 93534, not later than **11:00 A.M., THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2012.**

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Manufacture, deliver, install, and test the new septic system, associated equipment, and piping – A. D. Edmonston, Chrisman, Teerink, and Buena Vista Pumping Plants. a. Provide ADA compliant temporary portable sanitary facilities at each work site. Facilities at each site are to include separate portable bathrooms for male and female personnel; portable shower; and emergency shower station for hazard shower. b. At Chrisman Pumping Plant Only: Install new septic tank vent line using existing floor pass through and tying into an existing VTR (Vent to Roof) line located in the room directly above the septic tank room. 2. Remove from work site and properly dispose of existing septic system, associated equipment, and piping – A. D. Edmonston, Chrisman, Teerink, and Buena Vista Pumping Plants. 3. Manufacture, test, deliver, and install the electrical system for newly installed effluent pumps, sludge pumps, and sump pumps as a replacement for the existing electrical system for each of the pumps at each site with necessary devices required to accomplish the functions intended and as specified and/or shown. a. Provide necessary devices for assembly into the existing motor control centers and specified location. b. Dismantle and dispose of each existing device replaced with a new device, as the Contractor's property from the work site. c. Each existing pump control system with associated devices shall be replaced with new devices.
