Sealed bids for, CITRUS RESERVOIR, EAST BRANCH EXTENSION – PHASE II, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, SANTA ANA DIVISION, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 12-02, CONTRACT NO. C51448, will be received by the Department of Water Resources at San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District, 380 East Vanderbilt Way, San Bernardino, California 92408, not later than 11:00 A.M. on **THURSDAY, APRIL 12, 2012**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Constructing Citrus Reservoir: a. Clearing & grubbing b. Selective demolition. c. General excavation. d. Temporary on site material processing & stockpiling. e. Hauling of excavated material from the site. f. Spoil removal of boulders, cobbles & gravel & other unsuitable materials. g. Importing of materials to the site. h. Compacted embankment i. Compacted Soil Liner (CSL). j. Compacted soil liner enriched with asphalt emulsion. k. Hydraulic Asphalt Concrete (HAC) l. Asphalt mat. m. Concrete liner. n. Reinforcing steel. o. Rock slope protection. p. Reservoir access roads q. Spillway structure. 2. Inlet Works: a. Steel pipe and fittings. b. Insulating sleeve type couplings. c. Pipeline appurtenances. d. Pipeline encasement. e. Reinforced concrete stilling well and inlet chute. f. Install Department furnished valves, assemblies and actuators. g. Asphalt mat. h. Crushed Drain Rock (CDR). i. Miscellaneous metal. j. Miscellaneous electrical work. k. Coatings. & 3. Other Miscellaneous Features.

Response, if appropriate, will be furnished/sent to all prospective bidders on the DWR Planholder's List. A tour regarding the work site will be scheduled and conducted by the Department. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT INTERESTED CONTRACTORS ATTEND THE INSPECTION TRIP.**

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM, available only from the Department. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. Contractor's license classification required for this work: A . All bidders shall be prequalified by the Department. Bid documents will be furnished only to prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the State Contract Act and Document 00040 – Prequalification.

The Department encourages bidders to explore certification as a Small Business and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise and to utilize certified Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises during the contract term.
