Sealed bids for PIPELINE REPAIR UNDER WARM CREEK, SANTA ANA PIPELINE, MILE POST 422.5 AND 425.3, STATE WATER FACILITIES, CALIFORNIA AQUEDUCT, SOUTHERN FIELD DIVISION, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFICATION NO. 12-11, CONTRACT NO. C51457, will be received by the Department of Water Resources at the Lancaster Project Headquarters, 121 West Carriage Lane, Suite 101, Lancaster, California 93534, not later than **11:00 A.M. on THURSDAY, AUGUST 16, 2012**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at an announced location in the vicinity of such office.

The work is defined in Section 01110 – Summary of Work, and includes but is not limited to the following principal features:

1. Site 1: a. Approximately 306 feet of 102-1/2 inch outside diameter steel liner within the existing Santa Ana Pipeline (SAPL), made of Pre-Stressed Concrete Cylinder Pipe (PCCP) at Mile Post 422.5, under Warm Creek. The pipeline, at the project limits, has been classified as “Potentially Gassy” by the Mining and Tunneling Unit of the Division of Occupational Safety and Health. b. Cutting and removing one section of the existing PCCP for access to the segment of SAPL to be repaired. c. Transporting the removed section for storage at Lake Perris. d. Replacing the removed section after the installation with two sections of 111-1/2 inch outside diameter steel pipe. e. Grouting of the annular void between the steel liner and PCCP. f. Traffic control. g. Dewatering. h. Selective demolition. i. Earthwork: 1) Excavation. 2) Shoring. 3) Compacted backfill. j. Concrete formwork. k. Concrete and reinforcing steel. l. Cement mortar lining. m. Aggregate base. n. Environmental protection. o. Public safety. p. Furnish Engineer’s field office. 2. Site 2: a. Excavation, inspection, and repair work for Pipe Section Nos. 1210, 1211 and 1212. b. Home inspections.

Questions relating to bidding may be directed to the Contract Coordinator of DWR in Sacramento, at the contacts listed above. Questions or requests for clarification of the drawings or specifications shall be made in writing no later than 10 days before the scheduled opening of bids. Response, if appropriate, will be furnished/sent to all prospective bidders on the DWR Planholder’s List. A tour regarding the work site will be scheduled and conducted by the Department. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT INTERESTED CONTRACTORS ATTEND THE INSPECTION TRIP.**

Bid forms for this work are included in a separate booklet titled BID FORM, available only from the Department. Bids will be considered only if submitted for all the work required for the above project. Contractor's license classification required for this work: A or C-34 .

All bidders shall be prequalified by the Department. Bid documents will be furnished only to prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the State Contract Act and Document 00040 – Prequalification.

The Department encourages bidders to explore certification as a Small Business and/or Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise and to utilize certified Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises during the contract term.
