


**Where do you go in the case of a building evacuation?**







### 1ST FLOOR EMERGENCY ESCAPE ROUTES



## Explosions

April 28, 1973 Southern Pacific Train Yard, Roseville California. 21-car munitions train that caught fire and exploded carrying more than 7,000 bombs headed for Vietnam.



## Earthquakes

California, United States has had: (*Magnitude 1.5 or greater*) on 8/6/2015  
15 earthquakes on that day  
116 earthquakes in the 7 days prior  
600 earthquakes in the past month  
**6,564 earthquakes in the past year**
