	1 - Funding reduced to \$500,000 because current project is mostly structural fixes with relatively little additional habitat restoration. Since FPCP is intended to fund primarily nonstructural actions, the fit to the program is not optimal.															
	2 - Reduction of \$9 million from applicants' request places amount close to funding cap, with funds slated for purchase of fee and/or easement acquisitions and residential relocations for flood management purposes.															
	3 - Funding amount reduced because need for one-foot stage reduction in Tehama is being solved by FEMA elevating Tehama residences. Earthwork still needed; restoration can be funded from other sources or rely on natural recruitment.															
	4 -Project has lined up funding for summer 2003. Proposed FPCP will be used for summer 2004 planned activities. Project sponsor is pursuing other funding sources for future phases.															
	5 - Project is recommended for full funding, but was divided geographically for evaluation (see 4011b below). \$1,000,000 to go towards purchase and construction of 25-acre detention basin.															
	6 - Project withdrawn 07/28/03 so recommended funding reduced to zero.															
	7 - Remainder of Dry Creek funding request to be used for purchase of fee and easement acquisitions and Sesbania removal in the lower Dry Creek watershed in the Rio Linda area.															
	8 - Funding reduced to direct funds to nonstructural flood management and habitat restoration. Bridge construction will not be funded.
