Concept Proposals for 2016 Multi-Benefit Projects Solicitation Package

Thank you for the submittal of a Concept Proposal in response to the 2016 Projects Solicitation Package for Multi-Benefit Projects (PSP). Twenty-three Concept Proposals, for a total estimated cost of \$185 million, were received by the March 18, 2016 deadline.

Twenty-one proposals were deemed eligible and complete in the evaluation process and were scored against criteria in the PSP. Points were designated on a pro rata basis for the five scoring elements detailed in Section 5 of the PSP. These five elements are: External Financing, General Elements, Export Water Reliability, Ecosystem Enhancement, and Levee System Integrity. The maximum score possible for each proposal is 80 points. A list of the Concept Proposal scores is in the attached table. If your proposal is included in the attached table, you may submit a Full Application.

The Program invites each successful applicant to meet with us by June 15, 2016, to discuss their individual element scores and how they may improve their Full Application proposals.

This is a competitive process as described in sections 5B and 5C of the PSP. Selection to move forward to the Second Phase does not guarantee funding towards your project. The decision to submit a Full Application or not is solely that of the applicant.

This PSP provides for a maximum of \$60 million in total grant funding. Applications submitted in response to this PSP will be limited to no more than \$12 million in State funding per successful project. The goal of this PSP is to seek applications for balanced projects that integrate levee improvement (up to the DWR bulletin 192-82 template), habitat enhancement, emergency response, seismic resiliency, and export water supply reliability.

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Full Applications are due July 6, 2016.
