Costs and Benefits Summary

As shown in DWR Table 20, the Proposal provides significant water supply and other benefits. The total Proposal cost, expressed in present value terms, is approximately \$16,858,498. The Proposal will yield the following benefits, all expressed in 2009 dollars and present value terms:

- \$20,083,637 in flood damage reduction benefits
- \$0 in water supply benefits
- \$14,227,936 in water quality and other expected benefits

This equates to a present value of \$34,311,573 in monetized benefits alone, with benefits outweighing costs by a factor of 2.0.
