

**Attachment 9, Program Preferences-
14th Street Storm Water Collection and Integration Basin Project**

The proposed project is part of the "One Water One Watershed (OWOW) Plan" the Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) for the Santa Ana Region.

The project effectively integrates the different watershed projects within the Santa Ana Watershed And takes a holistic approach in addressing the various components of the IRWMP, as summarized below:

- Extends flood management, consistent with the City of Upland's Stormwater Drainage Master Plan and County of San Bernardino's Regional Flood Control Plan.
- Project is located within the boundaries of the Santa Ana Region, California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Region-8).
- Improve Water quality as required by the Santa Ana Region, California Regional Water Quality Control Board as stated in the latest NPDES permit.
- Enhance the reliability of local water supply by increasing groundwater availability consistent with California Department of Water Resources.
- Mitigate environmental concerns by reducing dependency on ecologically sensitive areas from the delta area and preventing local urban runoff from impacting downstream endangered species.
- Implements water use efficiency, water conservation, recycling and reuse to help meet future water demands.
