Proposal Objective*	<p>The Kern IRWM 2014 Drought Solicitation Implementation Grant Application consists of four multi-benefit projects that help address the current and future severe drought impacts in this Region. Taken together, these projects will achieve several of the Kern Region IRWM Plan objectives and increase cooperation and integration by multiple parties on long-standing local resource issues, especially in regards to the current drought. These Projects are described further below. Project 1 - The Buena Vista Water Storage District Brackish Groundwater Recovery Project allows an average annual recovery of up to 1,740 acre-feet of perched brackish groundwater for blending and beneficial reuse on crops and wetlands. Project 2 - The Kern County Water Agency Improvement District No. 4 CVC Lining Project consists of the lining of the CVC Extension Pool No. 7, substantially reducing seepage to an area underlain by groundwater with contaminants. Project 3 - The Arvin-Edison Water Storage District In-lieu Program consists of groundwater recharge/banking projects (two areas) and new reverse flow pumps are proposed for conservation of otherwise lost water and drought protection Project 4 - Buttonwillow County Water District Water Main Replacement and Meter Installation Project will implement water conservation measures in connection with water main replacement and new meter installation, thereby reducing annual groundwater pumping.</p>
