

The City of Mt. Shasta is the only groundwater user that will receive funding from the proposed grant. The City obtains its normal water supply from Cold Springs based on a pre-1914 appropriation water right that allows withdrawal of 100% of the Cold Springs yield in perpetuity for municipal purposes. The City also has additional source capacity from two groundwater wells; however, the wells typically only operate in the summer months during periods of high demand.
