

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING
THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A PROPOSITION 84
IRWM IMPLEMENTATION DROUGHT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA
DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES**

Whereas, in November 2006, the California electorate approved Proposition 84, the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Public Resource Code Section 75001 *et seq.*), which included funding for implementation grants for regions that had an adopted Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Plan; and

Whereas, in March 2014, Senate Bill 104 gave direction for an expedited 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Solicitation; and

Whereas, the Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County (WCVC) was formed by resolution and/or memoranda of agreements with local jurisdictions and/or agencies; and

Whereas, in the fall of 2006, WCVC stakeholders adopted the Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County IRWM Plan; and

Whereas, the County of Ventura was authorized, designated and requested by the Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County to file an application for the Proposition 84 2014 IRWM Drought Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura, hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application to the California Department of Water Resources to obtain an Integrated Regional Water Management Implementation Drought Grant pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Public Resource Code Section 75001 *et seq.*) and Senate Bill 104, and entry into an agreement to receive a grant for the implementation of Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County Integrated Regional Water Management Plan.
2. Authorizes and directs the County Executive Officer, or designee, of the County of Ventura to prepare the necessary data, conduct investigations, file such application as necessary to enter into and execute a grant agreement with the California Department of Water Resources.

Upon motion of Supervisor Long, seconded by Supervisor Bennett, and duly carried, the Board hereby adopts this resolution on June 17, 2014.
