The City of Cerritos is currently working with Gwen Huff of the Urban Water Use and Efficiency Unit of DWR to address the issues with the City of Cerritos 2010 UWMP. 

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the City of Huntington Park's (City) 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) received on July 20, 2011. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans. DWR's review of the City's 2010 UWMP has found that the plan has addressed the requirements of the CWC.

DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is meant to acknowledge that the City's 2010 UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.




